4. Principal's Update - Presented by Jennifer Edmondson-Neily

- **Welcome and Introductions:** Jennifer shared her excitement about joining QEHS and thanked the school community. She shared her previous experience as a school leader and the journey she had been on to get to this point.
- Highlights from School Start-Up: Enrollment for all grades 7-12 is at 945 and still growing as more families move into the community. A new whole school theme has been introduced to the students and teachers called 'Walking Together' which will be intertwined through all curriculum areas. Key areas of school development include, how the children are citizens in the school as well as wider community, relationships they have with others and assessment and feedback in learning.
